Supporting our Community through the Covid-19 Crisis

Raising funds to support our community across the Roseland through the Covid-19 Crisis

The CoronaVirus outbreak means that all of us are having to make dramatic changes in our day-to-day lives. For some in our Community this will be much tougher than for others.

Since the start of this crisis, the Charity has worked alongside Roseland Together, run by the RSPG, and some local commercial kitchens, to provide a **'Meals on Wheels'** service.

This service, free at the point of delivery, provides one simple, freshly cooked, three course meal, 7 days a week. Meals are cooked in commercial 5 star inspected kitchens by food safety qualified staff and delivered hot to the door. Since starting on Monday 23rd March the demand for the service has grown steadily and we expect it to continue to do so. We are currently providing around 200 meals a week.

We now need your help!

The cost of each meal to produce and deliver is around £8. Anything you can give, whether it be for one meal or one hundred, will be gratefully received.
