Treloan Lane Recycling Facility

Cornwall Council have given notice that on financial grounds the recycling banks at Treloan Lane car park will be withdrawn this autumn, and instead they will be concentrating on their kerbside collection service and larger recycling centres. They have advised that the removal of the banks will take place during the week commencing 14th September. We investigated the possibility of providing the service ourselves but it was clear that we don't have the resources either to commit to this, especially in the current circumstances. Cornwall Council have said that signage will be erected a few weeks prior to removal to ensure that people who use the banks are informed of their imminent removal, and giving information about the nearest household waste recycling centres. They will also monitor the area for approximately 6 weeks after removal to ensure the area is kept clean and tidy. Please note that the charity clothes recycling bank will not be removed by Cornwall Council and at the time of writing it is expected that this facility will remain in place and available for use.
